

POST: TEACHERS

Responsible to: Head of Primary and Secondary

Main Tasks:

- To carry out the professional duties of a qualified school teacher, namely:
- To implement and deliver an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for students and to assist in the development of the curriculum and policies.
- To monitor and support the overall progress and development of pupils as a teacher/tutor.
- To facilitate and encourage a learning experience which gives pupils the opportunity to achieve their potential and personal growth.
- To contribute to raising standards throughout the school.
- To contribute to whole school planning activities.
- To undertake school duties as required.
- To participate in the school's extra-curricular programme.
- To participate in all areas of the curriculum, including IT, Drama, Music, PE and Swimming.

Planning, Teaching and Classroom Management

- To secure and sustain effective learning of the relevant subjects for individuals, groups and classes. Develop the quality of teaching, assess the standards of pupils' achievements and set targets for improvement.
- Monitor student progress.
- Use a variety of teaching strategies to communicate clear objectives and expectations.
- Recognise achievements and make accurate assessments.
- Plan effectively taking account of the needs of all individuals.
- Take account of ethnic and cultural diversity to enrich the curriculum.
- To maintain high standards of discipline.
- Liaise with parents/guardians.
- To ensure that ICT, literacy, numeracy and subject specialisms are included in the learning experiences of all pupil.

Professional Development

- To take responsibility for own professional development, setting objectives, keeping up to date with developments in the subjects taught.
- To take part in the school's professional development programme.

Staff/Resources

• Work as a member of a team sharing expertise, ideas and information.

- Deploy other adults effectively in the classroom involving them, where appropriate, in the planning and management of pupils' learning.
- To support, develop and monitor the work of other adults in the area/classroom.
- To develop, share, monitor and control resources within the teaching area.

Pastoral

- To be a tutor/teacher to an assigned group.
- To promote the progress and well-being of the students in the group.
- To contribute to the development, implementation and review of the school's pastoral systems.
- To keep up to date records, as required.
- To communicate with parents/staff when concerned about individual students.

School Ethos

- To play a full part in the life of the school and to support its mission.
- To be concerned about health, safety and well-being of all in the school community.
